

Since the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) started in 2022, communities in Kansas have received nearly \$20 million for Comprehensive Safety Action Plan development and safety project implementation from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL). Through the Kansas SS4A Match Pilot Program (2022 and 2023) and the Kansas Build Fund (2024 and beyond), the State of Kansas has contributed over \$4 million toward the local public agency match.
