Project Update:

The proposed I-135/SE 36th Street interchange project would completely reconstruct the existing interchange on the south side of Newton to better serve the community and emerging business opportunities.


Improvements include a new three-lane bridge with shoulders, guardrail, a sidewalk on the north side of the bridge, updated lighting, improved drainage, highway signing, new pavement and pavement markings.

New development at the nearby business park and the SE 36th Street bridge condition have refueled the need for the improvement project.

Final designs will be complete in the fall of 2023. Because the bridge is nearing the end of its useful life, contractor selection (letting) is anticipated early next year. KDOT Right-of-Way will contact landowners to acquire the needed temporary easements to help with construction, and utilities will be relocated in advance of construction. Construction could begin as soon as the summer of 2024.
