KANSAS PANORAMA

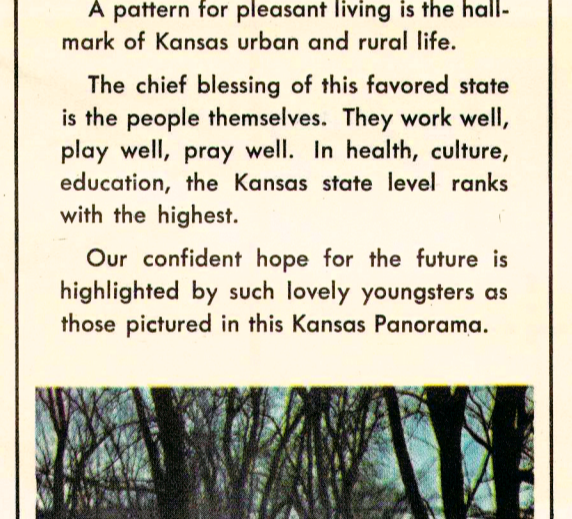
Prosperous, progressive Kansas offers to its people and to the nation a superlative variety of ever-changing beauty and ever-increasing opportunity.

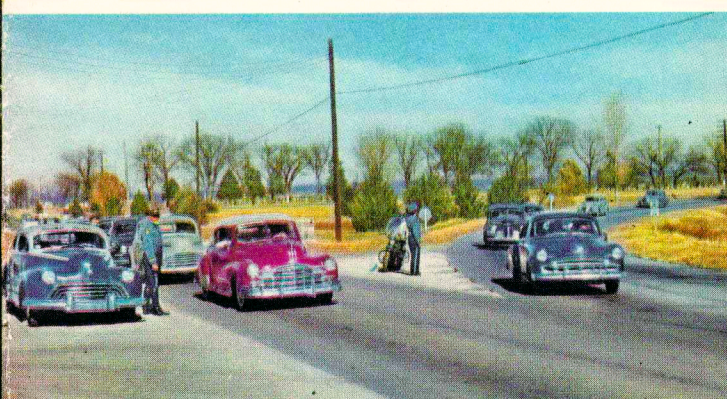
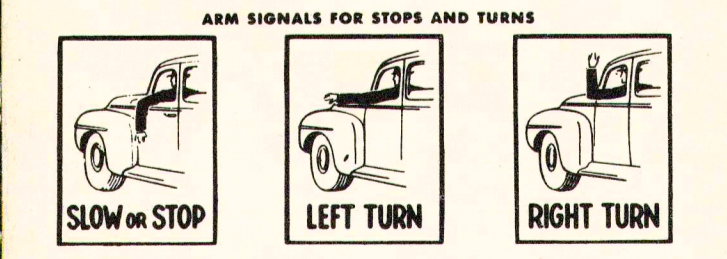
