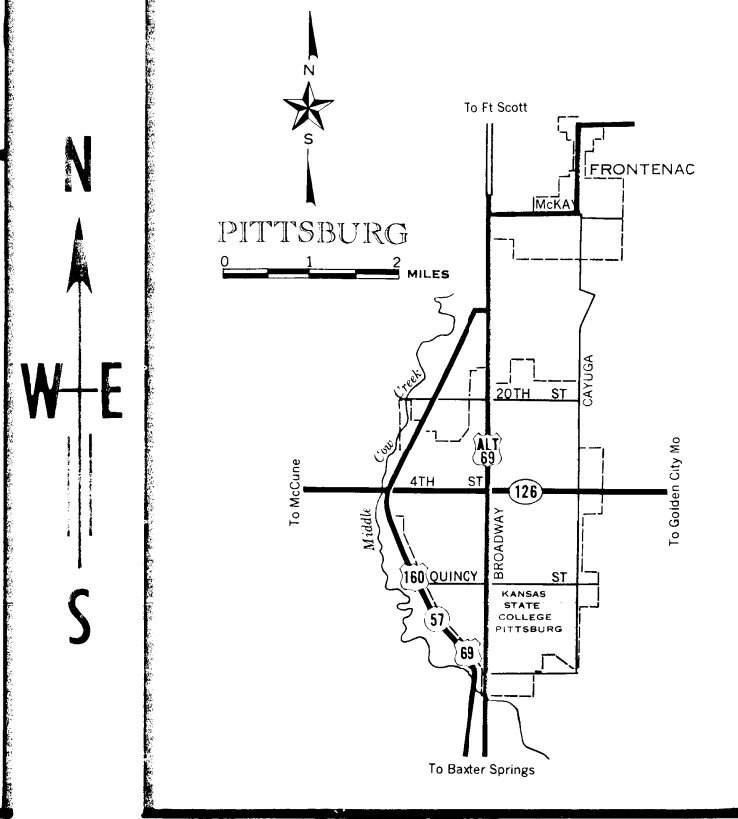
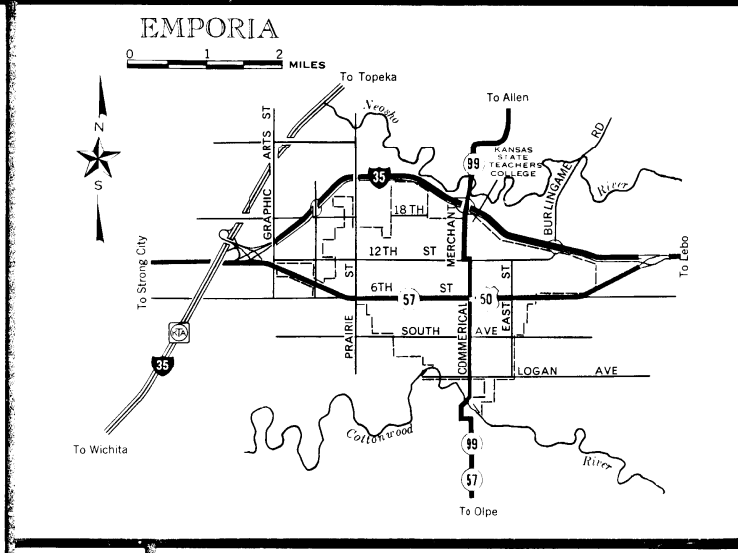
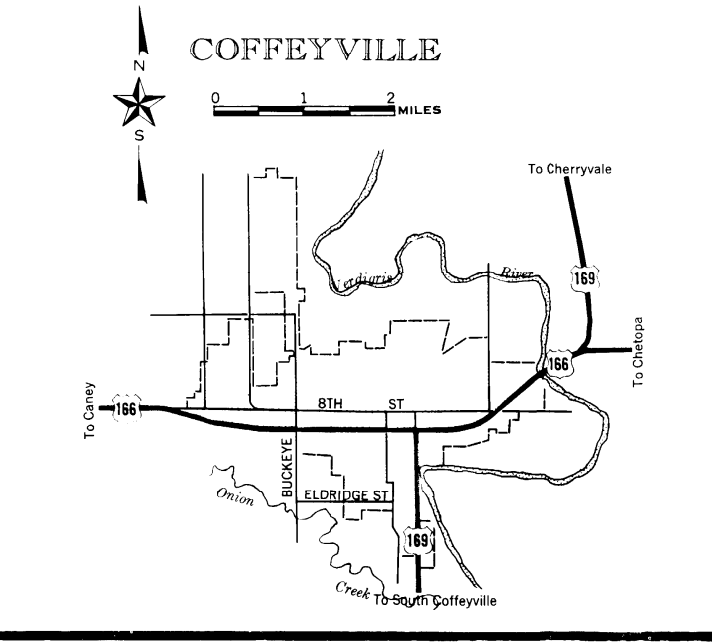
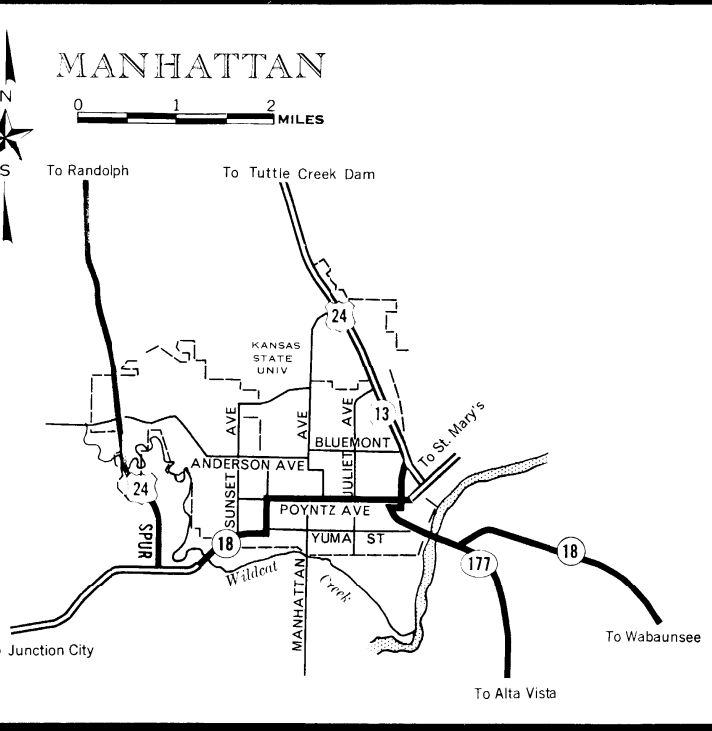
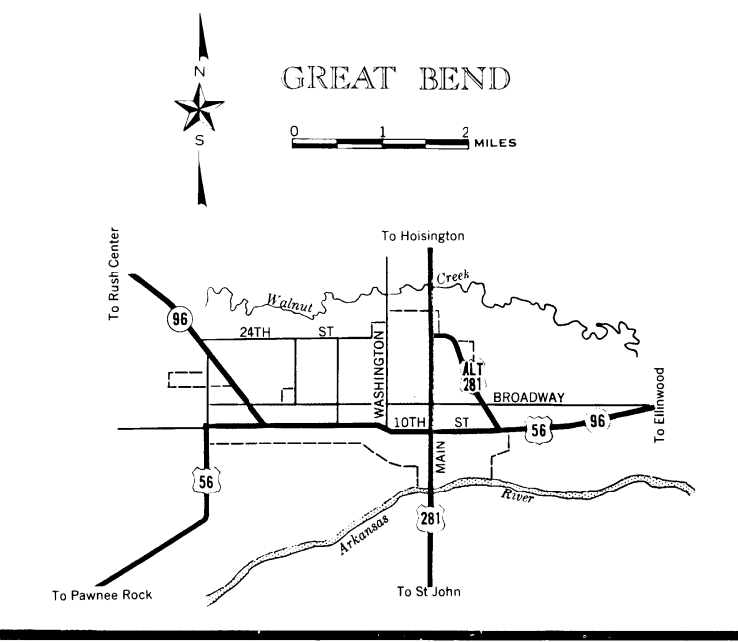
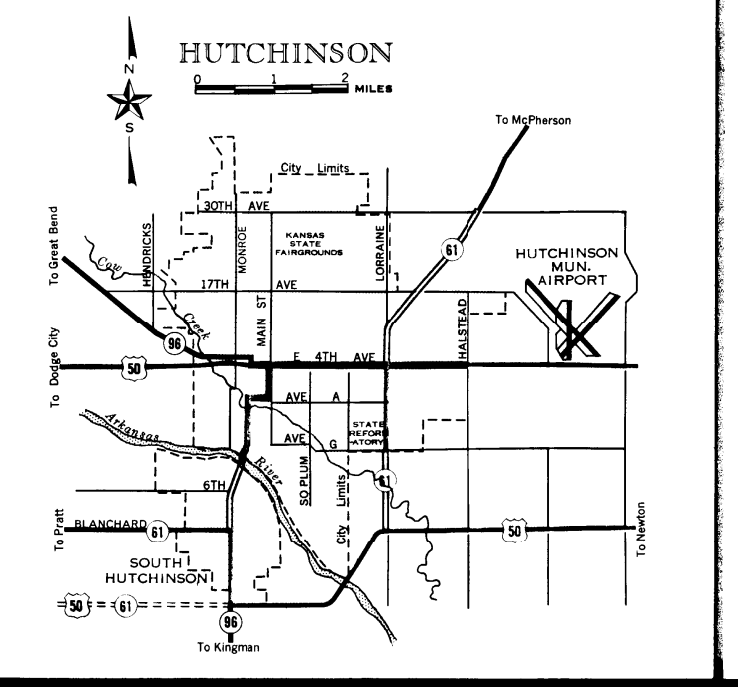
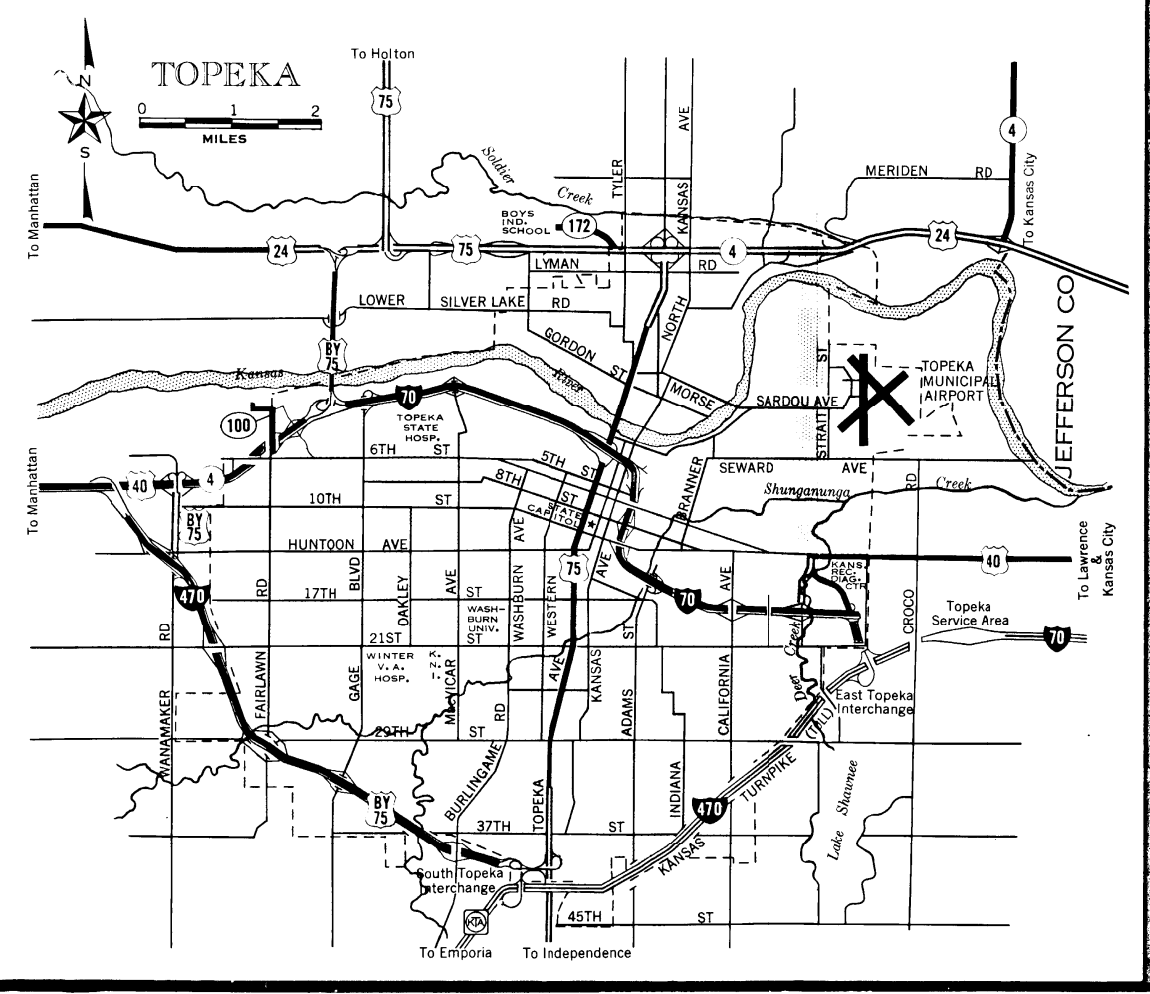
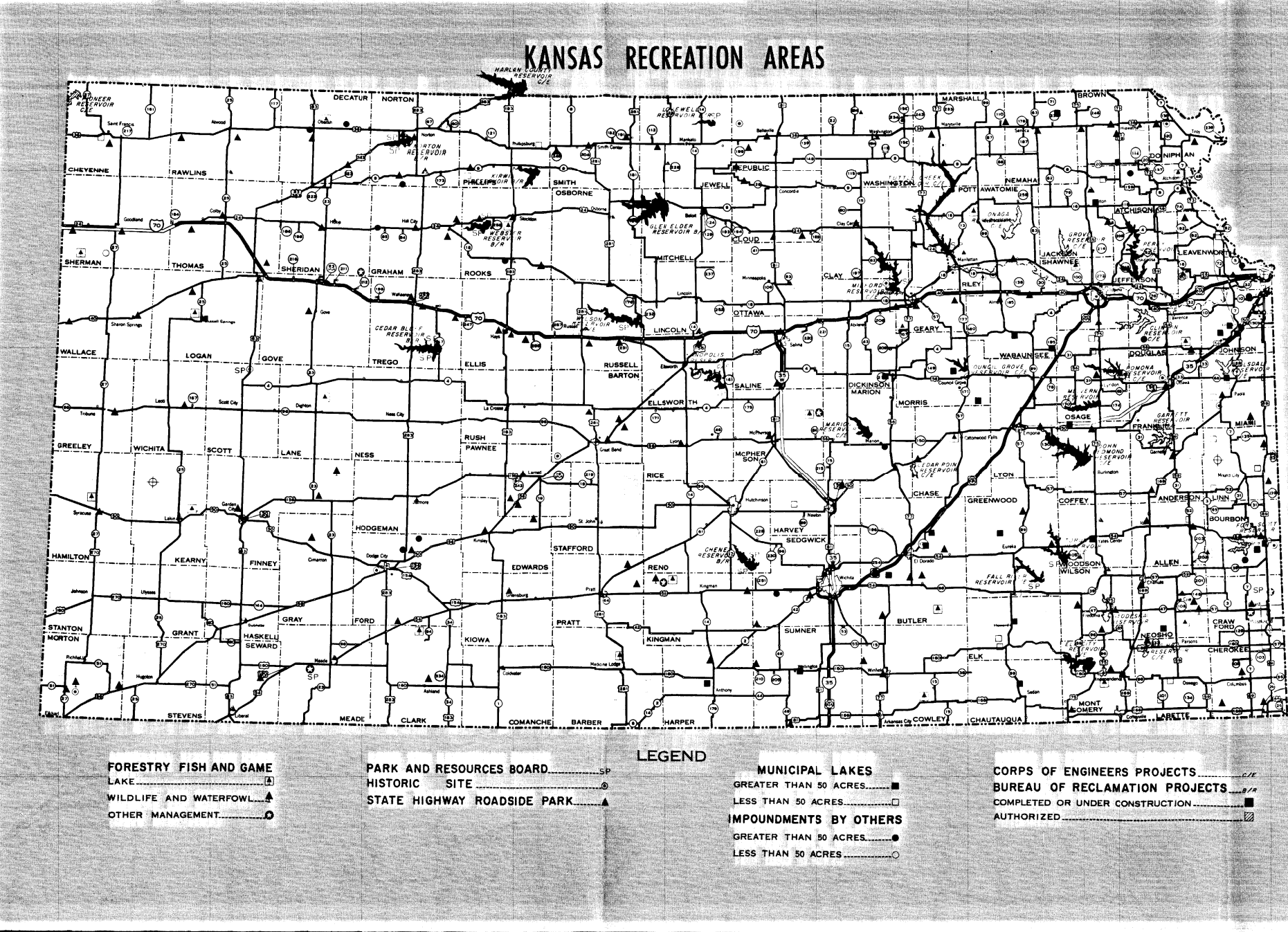
Kansas has 78% of its allotted 800 miles of Interstate Highway opened to four-lane traffic.
