SAFETY RULES IN KANSAS

Passenger cars, buses, and trucks under 8,000 pounds: 70 m. p. h. day, and 60 m. p. h. night on US and K routes...

Trucks over 8,000 pounds: 60 m. p. h. on US and K routes; Interstate Routes 60 m. p. h. with minimum of 40 m. p. h. day or night.

School Buses: 45 m. p. h. on activity trips on paved highways 55 m. p. h.

Kansas Turnpike: All vehicles 80 m. p. h. with 40 m. p. h. minimum.

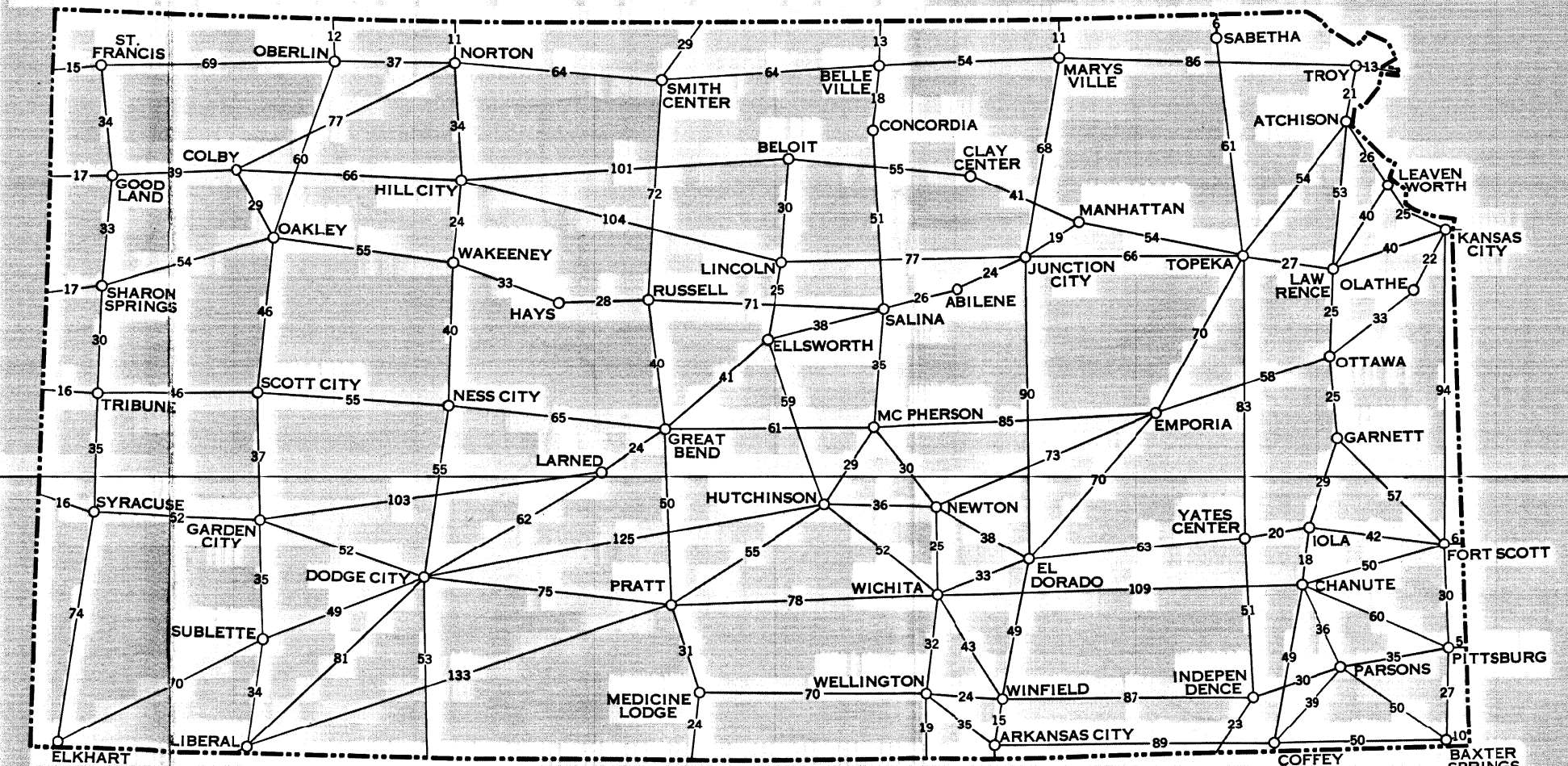
Free overnight camping is also allowed in all Highway Safety Rest Areas that have rest rooms.
