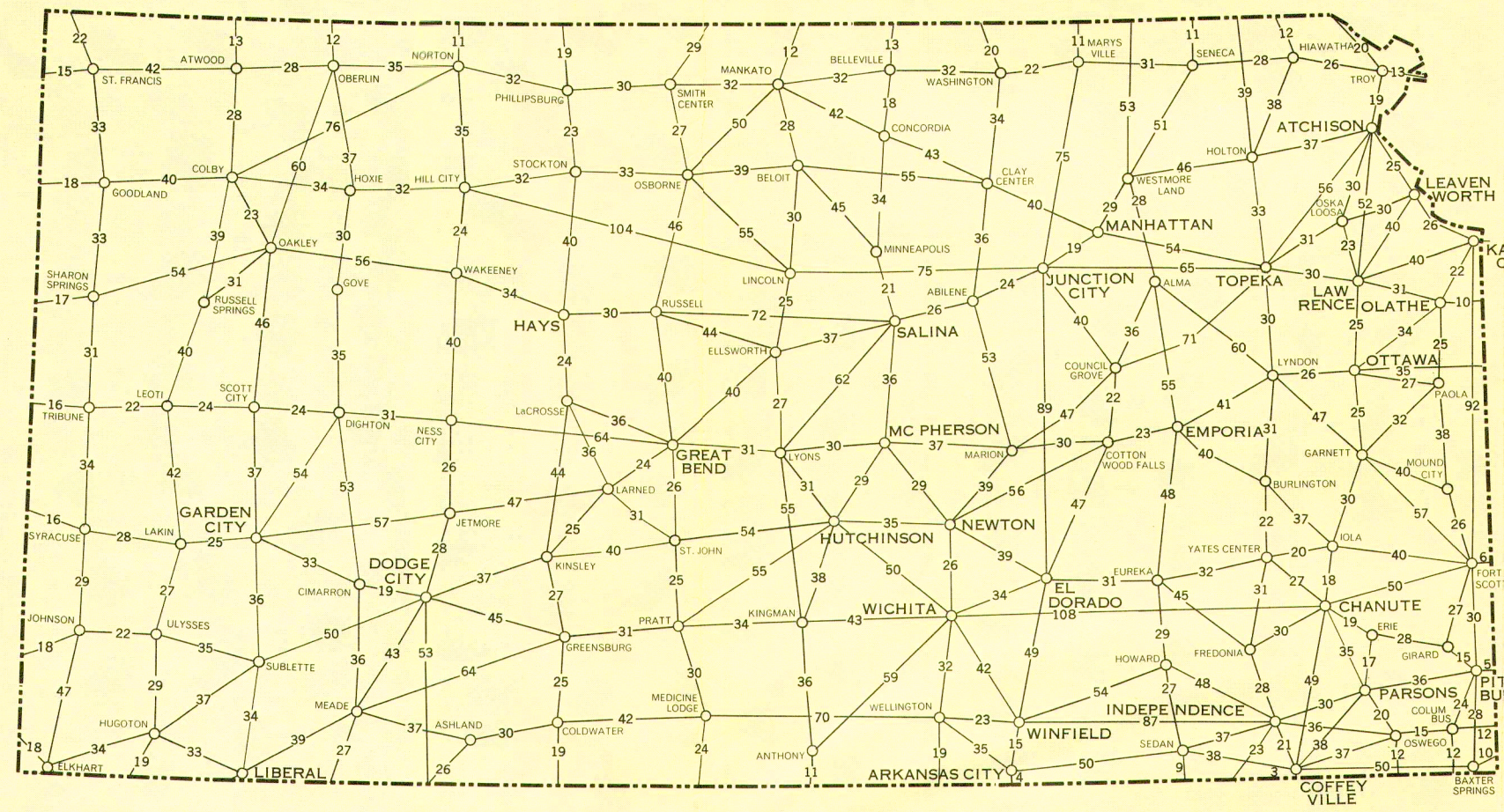


# Mileage Map

Mileages shown are between central junctions of cities shown, measured via shortest US, K, or Interstate route combinations. Use of the Kansas Turnpike (a toll road) will reduce some trip distances.



**Highway Speed Limits are posted at state borders; at highway junctions; at urban limits; and at terminals of reduced speed zones. Unless otherwise shown the following apply:**  
Passenger cars, buses, and trucks (licensed weight 8,000 lbs. or less)—US, and K numbered routes: 70 m. p. h. day; 60 m. p. h. night. Interstate routes and Kansas Turnpike: 75 m. p. h. day; 70 m. p. h. night; 40 m. p. h. minimum day or night.  
Trucks licensed over 8,000 lbs.—US, K and Interstate: 60 m. p. h. day or night. Minimum on Interstate 40 m. p. h. Kansas Turnpike—75 m. p. h. day; 70 m. p. h. night; 40 m. p. h. minimum.

Kansas subscribes to the Uniform Traffic Control Manual in its signing, delineation, and traffic law enforcement.  
Principal enforcement agency is the 347-man Kansas Highway Patrol and cooperating with them are the sheriff patrols and in the cities are the local police departments.  
Using the latest scientific aids available to enforce traffic laws including moving radar, aircraft and various analysis to determine blood alcohol contents, highway troopers do their utmost to protect the vast majority of law abiding drivers from the minority of motorists who operate their vehicles without proper regard for their own lives or more particularly for the lives of others.  
"Service, Courtesy and Protection" is the code.
