

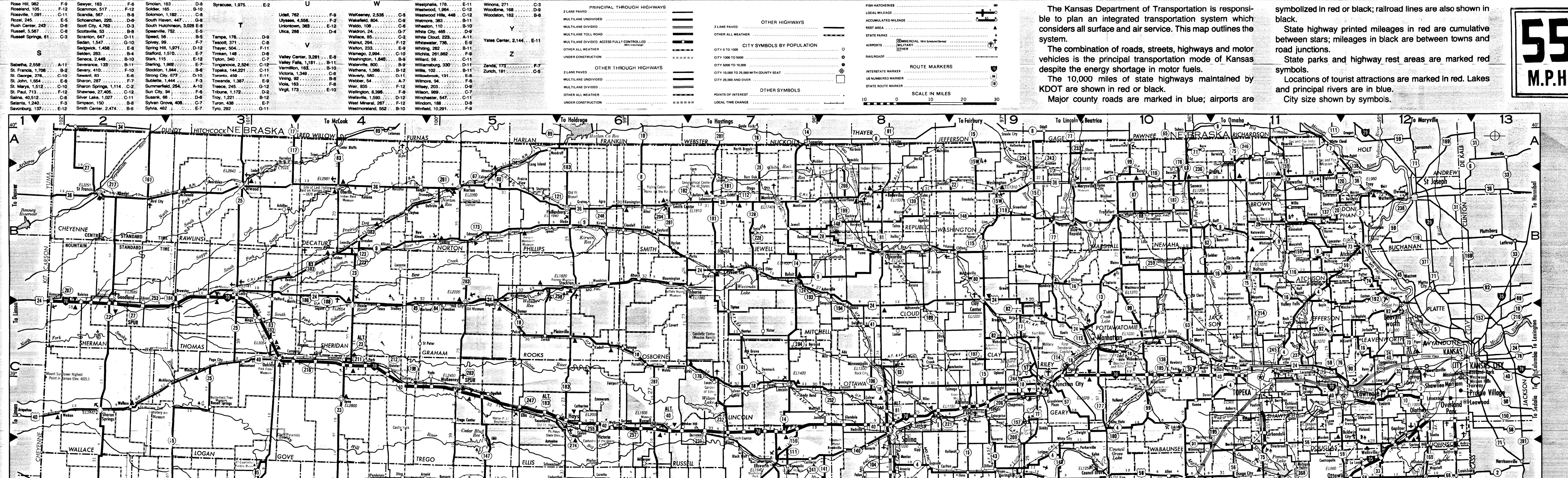

Mileage Chart

Mileage chart table showing distances between major Kansas cities. Columns list cities and rows show distances in miles.

The Kansas Department of Transportation is responsible to plan an integrated transportation system which considers all surface and air service. This map outlines the system. The combination of roads, streets, highways and motor vehicles is the principal transportation mode of Kansas despite the energy shortage in motor fuels. The 10,000 miles of state highways maintained by KDOT are shown in red or black. Major county roads are marked in blue; airports are symbolized in red or black; railroad lines are also shown in black. State highway printed mileages in red are cumulative between stars; mileages in black are between towns and road junctions. State parks and highway rest areas are marked red symbols. Locations of tourist attractions are marked in red. Lakes and principal rivers are in blue. City size shown by symbols.
