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Background

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Legislation

ADA was signed into law Jan. 26, 1990, and became effective Jan. 26, 1992. ADA makes discriminating against people with disabilities unlawful.

ADA comprises several sections of the United States Code compiled into five subject areas referred to as titles:

- Employment (Title I).
- Public services (Title II).
- Public accommodations and services operated by private entities (Title Ill).
- Telecommunications (Title IV).
- Miscellaneous (Title V).

Title II has the broadest impact on the Kansas Department of Transportation (Kansas DOT), as it specifically covers programs, services, or activities relating to areas of public transp01tation and updating existing infrastructure. Title II requires the Kansas DOT to develop a transition plan to bring facilities into compliance with ADA. This document presents the transition plan the Kansas DOT has developed for pedestrian facilities within the right of way.

Title II of ADA

Title II places emphasis on the accessibility of infrastructure within the public right of way. In order to achieve accessibility and consistency, public agencies are required to modify their policies, practices, and procedures to avoid discrimination without altering the fundamental nature of services, programs, or activities. Facilities required to be ADA compliant include:

- · Sidewalks,
- Crosswalks
- · Pedestrian ramps

Defining ADA Compliance

Buildings will be considered ADA compliant when they meet the criteria outlined in the

"U.S. Depa1t1nent of Justice's ADA Standards for Accessible Design" (2010). Elements in the right of way will be considered ADA compliant when they meet the criteria outlined in the "Proposed Guidelines for Pedestrian Facilities in the Public Right-of-Way" (2011).

Agencies Affected

All state and local governments are required to prepare a self-evaluation of all roadways and pedestrian facilities within their jurisdiction. In addition, all local governments with more than 50 public employees are required to develop a transition plan for all noncompliant facilities.

Because the number of city employees can fluctuate from year to year, the Kansas DOT conducted a survey to determine the average population associated with 50 city employees. The survey determined, as a general rule, cities in Kansas with more than 5,000 people had more than 50 city employees and should have their own transition plans.

Many of the pedestrian features located on the state highway right of way are owned and maintained by local governments. To avoid conflicts that may arise with local governments transition plans, the Kansas DOT has elected to defer to local governments' transition plans in areas of joint jU1'isdiction rather than producing duplicate plans for those areas. The Kansas DOT's transition plan will focus on areas without joint jurisdiction.

ADA Transition Plan

The purpose of the transition plan is to identify the steps the Kansas DOT will take to achieve ADA compliance for pedestrian facilities. These steps are:

- 1. Identify physical obstacles limiting the accessibility of programs or activities to individuals with disabilities.
- Describe in detail the methods that will be used to make facilities accessible. This
 detailed information is available upon request by contacting the Kansas DOT
 ADA/EEO/Employee Relations Bureau.
- 3. Develop a Schedule for achieving compliance.
- 4. Identify the Kansas DOT's ADA coordinators who will be responsible for ADA compliance.
- 5. Develop a grievance procedure to review complaints.

The first 4 steps are the minimum requirements for a transition plan as set forth by 28 CFR 35.150

The remaining steps are additional requirements for achieving ADA compliance as set forth by Title II.

In addition to the above steps, the Kansas DOT will track and report on their progress

To ensure ongoing compliance with ADA requirements, the Kansas DOT will perform periodic reviews of the plan and update as necessary. As a part of ongoing updates to the ADA Transition Plan, KDOT will continue to allow public comment and input with their plan.

ADA Coordinator

Greg Schieber, State Transportation Engineer is responsible for the implementation of Kansas DOT's Transition Plan, with the ADA Coordinators as the Administrator of the ADA Program.

The Kansas DOT's ADA/EEO/Employee Relations Bureau is responsible for all ADA Coordinator responsibilities. The contact information is:

The AADA/EEO/Employee Relations Bureau is responsible for coordinating and monitoring the progress of the ADA Program; however, many throughout the Kansas Department of Transportation contribute to the overall ADA compliance process.

Public Involvement

In 1993 KDOT included disability advocates in development of the original plan. Such advocates included disability advocacy groups in Wichita and Topeka.

Notification that changes have been made to the KDOT ADA Transition Plan and are available for public comment will be made by means of a statewide press release to all Kansas media sources and through social media avenues including but not limited to Facebook and Twitter. Comments can always be made by accessing KDOT's website and submitting comments as outlined on the following pages of this ADA Transition Plan.

The Kansas DOT will adopt and publish procedures for resolving complaints arising under ADA's Title II. The procedures are intended to set up a system for resolving complaints of disability discrimination in a prompt and fair manner. The next section provides the process and the form used to review complaints.

State of Kansas Grievance Procedure under The Americans with Disabilities Act

This Grievance Procedure is established to meet the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 ("ADA"), It may be used by anyone who wishes to file a complaint alleging discrimination on the basis of disability in the provision of services, activities, or programs by the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT).

The complaint should be in writing and contain information about the alleged discrimination such as the name, address, and phone number of complainant and location, date, and description of the problem, Alternative means of filing complaints will be made available for persons with disabilities upon request.

The complaint should be submitted by the grievant and/or his/her designee no later than 60 calendar days after the alleged violation to:

Within 15 calendar days after receipt of the complaint, the ADA/EEO/ Employee Relations Bureau Chief or their designee will meet with the complainant to discuss the complaint and the possible resolutions,

Within 15 calendar days of the meeting, the ADA/EEO/Employee Relations Bureau Chief or their designee will respond in writing, and where appropriate, in a format accessible to the complainant.

The response will explain the position of the Kansas Department of Transportation and offer options for resolution of the complaint.

All complaints received by the ADA/EEO/Employee Relations Bureau will be retained by the KDOT for at least three years.

Additionally, interested persons, including individuals with disabilities or organizations representing individuals are encouraged to submit comments on KDOT's ADA Transition Plan in writing to the ADA/EEO/Employee Relations Bureau utilizing the Grievance/Comment Form.



Grievance/Comment Form Public Accommodations

This form shall be used by anyone wishing to submit comments or file a grievance alleging discrimination on the basis of disability in the provision of services, activities, programs or benefits by the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT). This form should be submitted no later than **60 calendar days** after the alleged violation to:

Alternate means of filing complaints will be made available upon request. Within 15 calendar days after receipt of the complaint the ADA/EEO/Employee Relations Bureau Chief or their designee will meet with the complainant to discuss a possible resolution. A written response will be provided to the complainant with 15 days of meeting.

Featured Inventory

The next sections are devoted to KDOT's inventory of owned facilities, rest areas, sidewalks and bridges. The general information has been collected and is listed in each section.

- Bridges
- Buildings
- Safety Rest Areas
- Sidewalks

<u>Bridges</u> ADA Plan

KDOT currently has 188 bridges in our inventory that contain pedestrian facilities and evaluates the condition and the need for sidewalk facilities on these bridges at the time of major rehabilitation (typically a re-deck) or replacement. Coordination between KDOT Project Managers (Road Design and Area Engineer) as well as any applicable local entities is done during the preliminary design phase of these projects. If it is deemed that a sidewalk is needed at a particular location, the facility will be designed to meet current ADA, as well as other requirements. Additionally, when KDOT receives a complaint or a concern about any of these bridges related to whether they meet the current ADA requirements, KDOT will investigate and respond accordingly.

KDOT Policy directs that the KDOT Road Design Office dictates the geometry of sidewalk facilities and provides that information to the KDOT Bridge Design Office to be incorporated into the bridge design.

If there is a "Y" in the column it designates this building meets ADA requirements, including accessible parking. Such buildings do not have public restrooms. An "N" in this column indicates that the building does not meet all the requirements of the ADA. When are modifications scheduled? This is the date by which the necessary modifications are scheduled to be completed for those buildings where public services are provided.

On the next page is the inventory of Safety Rest Areas located adjacent to the State Highway System of Kansas that are the responsibility of the Kansas Department of Transportation. Funds for modifications, if needed in the future, do not appear as a separate budget line item, but come out of a budget for building repair and rehabilitation. One issue at many of these locations that was not listed as a deficiency is the need for truncated domes delineating sidewalk ramps leading into the parking lot. At the time that these ramps need modification or reconstruction, the appropriate surface will be installed.

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Sidewalks and Ramps

ADA Plan

On the next page is an inventory of the sidewalks located on state highway system right-of-way that KDOT is fully responsible for maintaining. In Kansas, most of the sidewalks on state highway system right-of-way are inside city limits and these routes are identified as City Connecting Links. Pursuant to Kansas Statutes Annotated (K.S.A.) 68-412, 68-412a and 68-416a, KDOT does not have the legal authority to maintain sidewalks identified on a City Connecting Link. Therefore, cities are responsible for the maintenance of sidewalks adjacent to state highways on City Connecting Links, except for those sidewalks that are on structures.

As set out in 28 CFR 35.13 3, local public entities are responsible for the maintenance (as defined as a process of maintaining or preserving someone or something) of sidewalks and curb ramps, including accessible features of sidewalks and equipment. Additionally, consistent with 23 U.S.C. Section 116(c), KDOT and project sponsoring local public entities enter into formal City/State Agreements for the maintenance of such facilities when funded in whole or part with state/federal funds and KDOT provides oversight for compliance with said agreements.

Kansas statutes do not require that a city be of a certain population before it is responsible for the construction or maintenance of its sidewalks. Many of the sidewalks shown in this report are remnants of old sidewalks that do not provide a path to a destination and are not required to be upgraded.

KDOT works with local public entities to evaluate the need for these sidewalks at the time of a major rehabilitation of the adjoining highway and will bring it up to standards if necessary. KDOT will address curb ramps during maintenance and resurfacing operations in accordance with the joint DOJ/DOT resurfacing guidance. Currently KDOT does not have any projects scheduled in the next 20 years that include the sidewalks identified on the following pages. Additionally, when KDOT receives a complaint or a conce1n about any of these sidewalks related to whether they meet the current ADA requirements, KDOT will investigate and respond accordingly.
