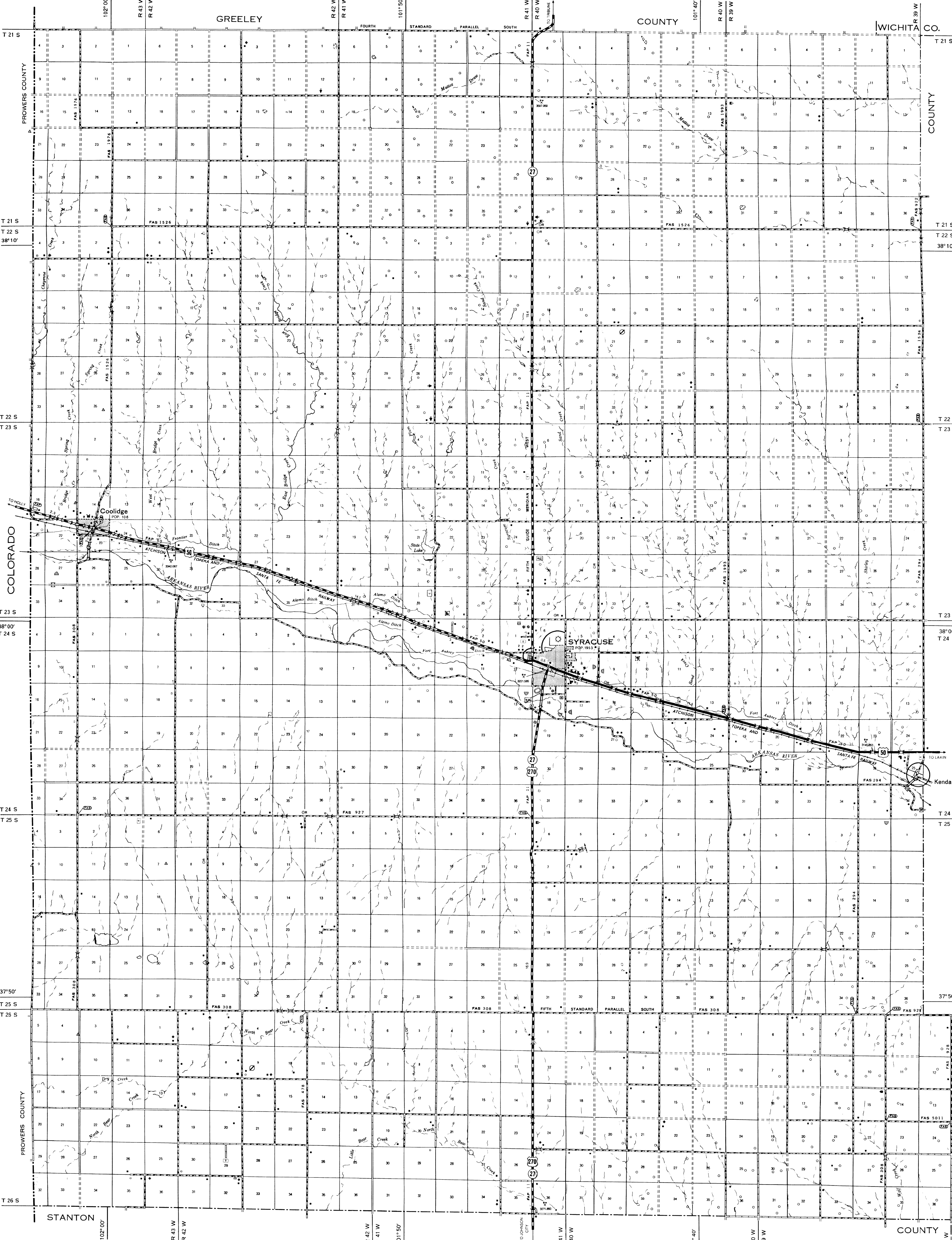


ENLARGEMENT SCALE

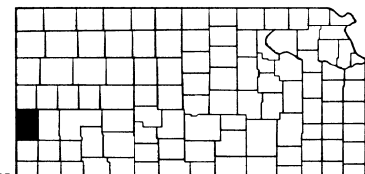
