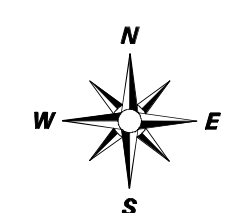
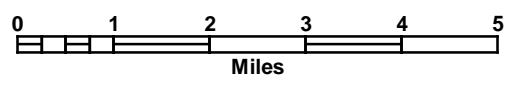

LAMBERT CONFORMAL CONIC PROJECTION

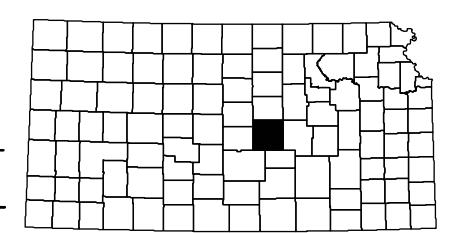
